

ORIC-UAF being the Secretariat of Institutional Biosafety/Bioethics Committee (IBC) makes utmost efforts to update the researchers about the latest developments in the field of Biosafety, Biosecurity, Bioethics and Dual Use Research Concerns (DURC) through various initiatives. In this regard, in collaboration with Health Security Partner (USA), ORIC arranged a series of 7webinars (from February 22, 2021, to March 15, 2021) to capacitate the researchers about Bio-Risk Management System, Establishment of IBC, their composition, reporting system and workability, Dual-Use Research Concern (DURC), Biosecurity it's components and comparison of IBC, with other relevant forums of the R&D Institutes including UAF and other universities in Faisalabad.
