NTU RANKING RESULTS 2021

National Taiwan University has released the results of the performance ranking of scientific papers for world universities. The 2021 performance measures are composed of eight indicators. These indicators together represent three different criteria of scientific paper performance: Research productivity, Research Impact, and Research Excellence.

NTU Ranking 2021 has declared the University of Agriculture, Faisalabad at 51st best in the world on the basis of scientific output in Agricultural Sciences. It is immense pleasure to share that only one Pakistani University has been included in the top 500 varsities by National Taiwan University (NTU) Ranking 2021 in Agricultural Sciences.

INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES BY MITACS GLOBALINK

The Mitacs Globalink has announced a 12-week research internship program for top-ranked undergraduate students to develop their research expertise, professional skills and gain international experience under the supervision of a Canadian university faculty member. Upon completion of the internship, the students will return to their home country but will be better positioned to find potential graduate supervisors for graduate studies in Canada.

The selection process for the session of summer 2022 has started. The Mitacs has decided to run a fully-funded pilot program this year for Pakistani undergraduate students. From next year, the partner country will be required to bear one-third of the cost (\$3000 CAD).

Benefits for students:

- 1. Ability to work with and learn from world-renowned Canadian Professors.
- 2. Access to state-of-the-art research facilities at top Canadian universities that have a dynamic and innovative research landscape.
- 3. Create a unique experience by combining academic research with co-curricular activities such as workshops and conferences. Extraordinary opportunities for teamwork and networking.
- 4. Connect with potential supervisors for graduate studies through Mitacs Globalink Graduate Fellowship or scholarship from a Canadian University.

Costs covered by Mitacs Globalink Internship program:

- · Round-trip airfare to Canada
- Transportation from airport in Canada to accommodations
- Stipend for housing (amount varies depending on country of origin)

- Health insurance
- ·Stipend towards student enrollment fees up to a maximum of \$300
- Stipend for food and incidentals (amount varies depending on country of origin)
- Registration for industry events, workshops, social activities, and professional development courses

- Funds should not be spent on brick and mortar.
- The details of training and/or experiments that will be performed and the goals that will be achieved should be clearly stated.

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Endowment Fund Secretariat (EFS) supports agricultural activities through projects relating to Technology Transfer, Product Commercialization and Research & Development. Proposals are invited from public sector universities/organizations with an established administrative and financial system for funding in the following domains:

Technology Transfer Product Commercialization Research & Development

- Priority will be given to projects under technology transfer and product commercialization. Funding for projects under R&D is limited.
- Proposals shall be evaluated by the experts for their technical strength and budgetary justifications. The final selection will be made

through a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Board of Directors (BoD).

- The duration of the project proposal should not exceed three years.
- Four hard copies along with a soft copy of the proposal in the prescribed format (available at www.efsuaf.org in downloads) complete in all respects, should be submitted through proper channel to the Executive Director, Endowment Fund Secretariat, 6-Main Road, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad up to 30.09.2021.

POST ENTRY QUARANTINE FACILITY AT UAF

It is a matter of great pride for the University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF) that the Ministry of Food Security and Research, Department of Plant Protection (Plant Quarantine Division) Govt. of Pakistan has issued a Certificate of Approval vide Registration No.PEQ-06/2021 (From 25-02-2021 to 24-02-2023) to Soybean Lab. at Center for Advanced Studies in Agriculture and Food Security (CAS-AFS) under the supervision of Dr. Zaheer Ahmad, Assistant Professor, Department of Plant Breeding and Genetics to test and certify the material as Post Entry Quarantine facility on the prescribed rates of the university. Dr. Zaheer Ahmad will extend this facility to the researchers, Public and Private Sector Organizations, NGOs and Farmers/Civil Society under the framework and Commercialization Policy of the university.
