PAKISTAN: DIRECT AID PROGRAM 2022-23

Direct Aid Program (DAP) by Australian Govt. is to support projects with a strong development focus that complement Australia's broader aid program which contributes to sustainable economic growth and poverty reduction.

Funding Information

• There is no minimum amount that a single DAP project can receive but the maximum is AUD60,000 over the life of the project. Activities may run up to a maximum of two years.

Eligible Projects

- DAP enables to promote activities that have a direct, practical and immediate impact, including capacity building programs in the areas of governance and human rights engagement.
- In the areas of community and/or rural development, education, gender equality, disabilities, youth, human rights, the environment, small-scale infrastructure, economic empowerment and ad hoc humanitarian relief.
- Where applicants and their communities make a contribution in labour, materials, transport or cash **Time line**: September 30, 2022

OPEN CALL FOR PAKISTAN PRIVATE SECTOR ENERGY

The Private Financing Advisory Network (PFAN) has announced the Pakistan Private Sector Energy Project (PPSE) to focus on expanding the portfolio of commercially-viable clean energy projects in Pakistan and providing support to enable them to access financing and reach financial close.

Supported by USAID, the project targets small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in Pakistan, including those located in industrial zones, while also addressing the needs of isolated communities through off-grid solutions.

Funding Information

• Only for energy access and rural electrification projects (clean cook stoves, solar home systems, mini grids) can get funding between US\$500,000 and US\$50 million. This too may be disbursed in smaller tranches as requested.

USAID LONG-TERM EXCEPTIONAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROJECT LOCAL PROGRAM



Financial coverage


The funding covers travel and accommodation of foreign & national speakers, publication, stationery and contingencies as per PHEC rules and polices.
