The event was organized at Rafhan Maize Product where chief executive officer/managing director Rafhan Maize Humair Ijaz and Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Igrar Ahmad Khan (HI, SI) signed the agreement. Discussing the overall agriculture and rising trend of malnutrition in the country, Dr Igrar Ahmad Khan said that to arrest the trend we need to promote mixing of maize flour in wheat that would help ensure the food security, nutrition intake and will make the agriculture a profitable business.

Dr. Igrar Ahmad Khan said that the maize farmers are prosperous and getting high production and income. He called for developing modern maize products and bringing them to the market.

Talking about malnutrition, he said that if roti is prepared from a mixture of wheat and corn flour, it will also help overcome the nutritional crisis.

Talking about soybean, he told that the country was currently spending a huge foreign exchange of 1.5 billion dollars to import soybeans and the varieties developed by the University of Agriculture, Faisalabad are being planned to be cultivated in one million acres to reach the common farmers.



Humair Ijaz said that Rafhan Maize Products has been working as the first Miaze Refinery since 1953. They are bringing innovation in corn and making its best food product for the last 70 years. He said that innovation can be made possible along with developing the industry on scientific basis by promoting academia-industry relations.

Pakistan Science Foundation (PSF) & The Scientific and Technological Research Institution of Turkey (TÜBİTAK) Under Competitive Research Program (CRP)

(This call is open between March 18th, 2024 to June 3rd, 2024)

Pakistan Science Foundation (PSF) under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with The Scientific and Technological Research Institution of Turkey (TÜBİTAK) invites joint R&D proposals from the HEC Chartered/Recognized Universities, Public Sector Research Institutions (only the regular faculty members/researchers) in collaboration with Industry in the following areas;

1. Artificial Intelligence (AI) 2. Internet of Things (IoT) 3. Electric Vehicles 4. Oceanography
The aim of the call is to strengthen the cooperation between Turkish and Pakistani scientists/researchers in science and industry by means of Academia-Industry Cooperation in scientific research projects.

The Pakistani side should submit the proposals through Research Grant Management System (RGMS) available at PSF Website (www.psf.gov.pk) whereas from the Turkish Side, the proposals should be submitted through TÜBİTAK's Project Application System (http://uidb-pbs.tubitak.gov.tr). PSF will support the projects upto Rs. 20.00 Million whereas TÜBİTAK will support projects upto 4.00 Million Turkish Lira (TL). The maximum duration of the project must not exceed 2 years. The detailed guidelines are available at https://rgms.psf.gov.pk/rgms/signup.aspx. Complete applications to be submitted through ORIC-UAF one week ahead of the closing date.
