Visit of PSF Team to UAF

Pakistan Science Foundation is a key funding agency, fostering a country-wide campaign for research, innovation and cutting-edge Technologies within the higher educational institutions, including University of Agriculture, Faisalabad. Presently, 15 significant research projects in UAF are being financed by PSF. This organization also oversees activities related to the research projects it funds, so a visit to UAF by the monitoring team from PSF is scheduled on May 17-19, 2016 at ORIC. The team, comprising of subject/ financial experts, is entrusted with the tasks of ensuring transparency in the ongoing activities of the project(s) and of accelerating their pace along with looking into matters related to the technical & fiscal aspects of the projects(s). ORIC has chalked out a detailed plan to facilitate a meeting between PIs (including Co-PIs, and Research Associate) from UAF and PSF visiting team. The copies of this plan have been circulated among all concerned in due course through proper channel. All the PIs, Co-PIs, and Research Associate executing PSF funded research projects are requested that they should be very particular to make themselves available on the scheduled dates, alongwith relevant record/data of the respective projects.

Constitution of Institutional Biosafety Committee

Under the Pakistan Biosafety Rules 2005, and National Biosafety Guidelines notified vide No. 2(7)95-Bio, establishing an Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) was made mandatory for each and every of those public sector institutes and organizations which are engaged or intending to engage in the purchase, construction or propagation of all field release Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs) or components. Such an Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) was meant to establish itself as an administrative authority for the purposes of providing standard guidelines and ensuring strict compliance to biosafety rules in its respective parent organization. Thereby, as per the terms of Section 8 of the Pakistan Biosafety Rules 2005 notified vide No. S.R.O (1) 336 (1)2005, dated 21-04-2005, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF) constituted (vide notification No. A-4/396-04/31332 dated 10-11-2009 and No. 6035/ ORIC, dated 06-10-2011) its own Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC), comprising of the following members:

Proposed NRD Research Priority Areas for 8th APL Batch:

- 1. Management of sodic soil and high RSC waters for sustainable crop production in salt affected lands.
- 2. Use of microbes for supplementing fertilizers and their role in inducing a biotic stresses in crops.

- 3. Use of nano technology in fertility management and handling of soil environmental issues.
- 4. Prospectus for enhancing efficiency of nitrogen and P through chemical and biological means.
- 5. Health risk assessment and remedial measures of contaminations in soil and food chain.
- 6. Integrated nutrients and crop residue management for intensive crop production and soil health.
- 7. Bio fortification of micronutrients in cereal crops for improving human health.
- 8. Management of ground brackish water through solar desalination technology for promotion of Agriculture.
- 9. Nutrient management for arid, semiarid and mountainous areas.
- 10. Climate change impact assessment, adaptation and mitigation for sustainable agriculture development.
- 11. Integrated agricultural water management for increased water productivity in various agro-ecological regions of the country.
- 12. Integrated watershed management interventions for sustainable resource use and livelihood improvement.
- 13. Harnessing alternate energy resources for environment frienesting and spate irrigation for on—farm water conservation and crop water productivity.
- 15. Improving Range and Livestock Productivity with integrated range-livestock approach.
- 16. Rangeland status and trend assessments, sustainable range management and valuation of range ecosystem services.
- 17. Agro-forestry in relation to climate smart agriculture in various agro ecological zones.
- 18. Afforestation for energy, carbon sequestration and green economy.
- 19. Assessment of tree damage from diseases and management strategies.
- 20. Conservation and promotion of non timber forest products for livelihood improvement.
- 21. Genetic improvement of Apis Cerana, for quality honey production.
- 22. Management of Apis mellifera for improvement in honey yield and development of value added products.
- 23. Conversation and management of pollinators for sustainable agriculture through an eco-system approach.
- 24. Horticulture in arid and mountainous areas for promotion and value addition of fruits and vegetables of economic importance.
