"Battling Climate Change & Water Crisis – Technology Nexus for the Resonance of Humans and Nature",



The Institute of Soil and Environmental Sciences (ISES), in collaboration with Office of Research Innovation and Commercialization(ORIC), University of Agriculture Faisalabad organized a Symposium/Panel Discussion on 29 October 2018 "Battling Climate Change & Water Crisis – Technology Nexus for the Resonance of Humans and Nature". State Minister for Climate Change, Ms Zartaj Gull graced the event as Chief Guest. She stressed that a comprehensive and viable policy was necessary to address the challenges related to changing climate and water issues.

The minister said that previous governments failed to facilitate the public, resultantly, all the sectors of economy especially agriculture sector failed to mitigate the emerging problems of water shortage and climate change. She added that the present

government was keen to make Pakistan Clean and Green. She told that the south Punjab was already facing shortage of water and the availability of good quality, arsenic-free water was also declining each day. Notably, the minister appreciated that the scientists of UAF had made sound discoveries about arsenic treatment of drinking water and safe reuse of wastewater.

Regarding water issues, she said with concern that Pakistan had a storage capacity of 30 days as against the benchmark of 1000 days.

Earlier the Vice Chancellor, Prof Dr Zafar Iqbal while addressing the participants stressed the need to sensitize people to conserve water. Prof Dr Javaid Akhtar, the Director ISES welcomed the minister



alongwith participants and elaborated status of water declining and contamination in Pakistan while Dr Irshad Bibi, Assistant Professor of ISES presented the current scenario of water scarcity and quality situation globally with a special focus on Pakistan. Prof Dr Ashfaq Ahmad, Chair Climate Change, USPCAS briefly informed about the climate situation in Pakistan and how it was affecting the population and efforts for food security.

Ms Zartaj Gull, the State Minister for climate change finally thanked the VC, Director ISES, Dr Ashfaq Ahmad and Dr Nabeel Khan Niazi alongwith other organizers of this excellent and marvelous event on such a burning issue of Pakistan.

Applications are invited for the academic year 2018-19 from Pakistani/AJK faculty members of HEC recognised universities under the Higher Education Commission's project titled Faculty Development Programme for Pakistani universities. The scholarship programme will provide an opportunity to faculty members of public and private universities/Degree Awarding Institutions (DAIs) to pursue PhD degree at selected HEC recognised Pakistani universities/DAIs. The scholar can avail scholarship for a maximum period of four years including 6-12 months at foreign university.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Must be Pakistani/ AJK nationals.
- 2. Must have minimum 18 years of education with MS/MPhil/equivalent degree for PhD admission in the relevant field.
- 3. Must have two years of consecutive teaching experience in the parent University/DAIs.
- Must have 1st Division (in annual examination system) or minimum CGPA 3.00 out of 4.0 in the final degree and no 3rd Division/Grade D in the entire academic career.
- 5. Maximum age limit on closing date is 45 years.
- 6. The faculty members who are already enrolled in PhD (beyond Spring 2018) or availing HEC/Government /university or any other scholarship are not eligible to apply.
- 7. Applicant must be a faculty member of HEC recognised university, and will re-join after completion of studies as per terms and conditions of the scholarship award.
- 8. Visiting/adjunct faculty members are not eligible to apply.



Applications are required to be submitted online at http://eportal.hec.gov.pk/fdp. Hard copy of application and other documents will be required at later stages. Original online deposit slip/ ATM Transfer Slip of Rs. 500/-(non-refundable) as application processing fee in favor of Director General Finance, HEC. Fee can be deposited through any bank in Account Number 1742-79001334-01 Habib Bank Limited.
