SIX FACULTY MEMBERS JOIN BACK AFTER TRAINING FROM CHINESE UNIVERSITIES

Under the Prime Minister's initiative to enhance agricultural capacity in Pakistan, six faculty members from the University of Agriculture, Faisalabad have successfully completed short-term training programs at leading Chinese universities. This initiative is part of a broader plan to send 1,000 agricultural professionals to Chinese institutions for skill development aimed at promoting innovation, increasing productivity, and advancing sustainable growth in Pakistan's agriculture sector. The program specifically targets agricultural graduates, academicians, and researchers with at least two years of relevant professional experience. It is structured in three phases, with the first batch of 292 trainees dispatched to the province of Shanxi in April 2025. Among them were Dr. Fareeha Shireen (Assistant Professor, Institute of Horticultural Sciences), Dr. Faisal Masoud (Lecturer, Institute of Microbiology), Mr. Muhammad Rehan (Lecturer, Institute of Animal & Dairy Sciences), Mr. Kashif Igbal (Lecturer, Institute of Physiology & Pharmacology), Rao Husnain Arshad (Lecturer, Department of Irrigation and Drainage), and Ms. Muneeba (Lecturer, Department of Agronomy).Dr. Fareeha Shireen and Mr. Rao Husnain Arshad received training at Shaanxi Agriculture and Forestry Technology University, specializing in seed production and processing technologies and high-efficiency irrigation systems, respectively. Meanwhile, Dr. Faisal Masoud, Mr. Muhammad Rehan, Mr. Kashif Igbal, and Ms. Muneeba attended programs at Northwest A&F University, focusing on livestock disease monitoring and prevention, livestock surveillance, and seed production and processing technologies. This collaborative effort was sparked by the Prime Minister of Pakistan's visit to agricultural universities and research institutes in China last year, aiming to foster closer ties in agricultural education, research, and trade. Acting on the directive, the Ministry of National Food



Security and Research (MNFSR) invited applications from young professionals in both public and private sectors to take part in the initiative, which is being rolled out in phases. The second batch of trainees has recently departed for China and has been encouraged to uphold discipline and actively contribute to the strengthening of China-Pakistan cooperation, particularly in science and technology. The training program aligns with the broader objectives of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), incorporating climate-smart agricultural practices to support sustainable farming. The inaugural cohort completed its three-month training at institutions in Shaanxi from April 16 to July 17, 2025, marking a significant milestone in Pakistan's efforts to modernize its agricultural sector through international collaboration.
