and impact, small farmers' struggles: land access, credit, and support systems, post-harvest losses & value addition: wasted effort or missed opportunity?, agrientrepreneurship & startups: youth's role in Pakistan's agricultural future, livestock & dairy industry: neglected pillars of the agricultural economy, peri-urban agriculture: feeding cities and greening spaces, forests, rangelands & bio-diversity: missing links in agricultural policy, and rural development through agriculture: empowering communities. This initiative aims to educate viewers on the real problems behind surface-level issues and foster innovative solutions for Pakistan's agricultural sector.

The first panel discussion was held yesterday, featuring Chairperson Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) Prof. Dr. Iqrar Ahmad Khan (HI, SI), Prof. Dr. Asif Kamran (Agri. Policy & Governance), and Prof. Dr. Nadeem Akbar Sandhu (Chairman Agronomy). Experts from various agricultural disciplines will contribute empirical evidence to make these discussions impactful and meaningful.

The expo was organized by National Desisted Management Authority (NDMA) Islamabad wherein UAF showcased innovative solutions for flood forecasting, food security, locust and dengue control.

Dr. Musadik Masood Malik, Federal Minister, Climate Change & Environmental Coordination and Lieutenant General Inam Haider Malik, Hilal-E-Imtiaz (Military) Chairman, NDMA Pakistan visited the UAF stall and appreciated the effort of UAF for remarkable achievements to mitigate the upcoming challenges regarding food security. Dr. Iftikhar Ahmad, Director Business Incubation Centre further briefed the chief gust about latest technologies which are developed by UAF Scientists.

While pitching these technologies, our researcher, Dr. Sikandar Ali, presented his research on Transboundary Flood Management and Impact of Indian Dams on Chenab River, which was appreciated by 45 Engineer Division of Pak Army. On 2nd day, team UAF was invited to HQ, where Dr. Sikandar Ali presented his findings in detail. His presentation was focused on Impacts of Indian Dams on Chenab and Jhelum Rivers, risks associated with various Water Storage and Release Scenarios, Flood Forecasting, and Flood Early Warning System. The GOC of 45 Engineer Division carried out an in depth discussion, appreciated and offered his support to implementing these findings for strategic benefits.


